

Green shoots visible, India will bounce back: Niti Aayog CEO

New Delhi, July 7

NITI AAYOG CEO Amitabh Kant on Tuesday said green shoots are visible and the economy, which has been hit hard by the Covid-19 pandemic, will bounce back soon.

The pandemic has impacted economic activities severely as the country had to go through a nationwide lockdown to check the spread of coronavirus. The government had to announce a slew of measures, including fiscal package, to boost the economy. "I am a great believer that India will bounce back. We are already seeing green shoots in the economy. We are seeing that key sectors like FMCG (fast-moving consumer goods) have already come back."

"I am hopeful that we will bounce back and bounce back with a vengeance," he said while speaking at 'FICCI FRAMES 2020'.

The slowdown in economic activities led to a decline in the

government's revenue collection. However, with the gradually unlocking, economic activities are reviving. GST revenue collection in June rose to ₹90,917 crore from ₹62,009 crore mopped up in May and ₹2,294 crore in April. Kant further said the pandemic is a massive challenge not merely for India but for the whole world, including the US

and European countries.

"Every crisis is also an opportunity. Therefore, this crisis is also going to have huge losers and winners. India can decide whether it wants to lose or whether it wants to win," he said.

Kant stressed that India must pick up 12-13 areas of growth that are going to emerge as winners for tomorrow and listed out areas like

data, artificial intelligence, geonomics, mobility, and creative industry. "We must identify 12-13 sectors where India must become a global champion and really drive vigorously with full energy," he said adding that those sectors will take India to sustain high growth over the next 10-12 years and create a vast number of jobs.

On the Aatmanirbhar Bharat initiative, Kant said it is not about isolation and anti-globalisation.

"It is about getting the best from the world. It's about creating world-class products. It's not about protectionism. It's about abilities of Indian companies to create world-class products, capture the Indian market and then use the strength of the domestic market to penetrate the global market," he said.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi had announced the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan with the aim to make India a self-reliant country.

TVS Motor expects growth to pick up in second quarter

possibility of normal monsoon may support agriculture growth, and since much of the sales of two-wheelers are in semi-urban and rural areas, these could see some benefit, the company pointed out.

The restriction on public mobility and the impact on many sectors of the economy will affect the GDP, disposable incomes, consumer sentiment and the auto industry as well, the company said.

Consequently, a sharp decline in the first quarter of 2020-21 is expected, which may partially alleviate in the following quarter, with any upside possibilities only playing out in the later part of the year, the report stated.

Face masks, hand sanitisers no more under Essential Commodities Act

FACE MASKS AND hand sanitisers are no more essential products as their supply is sufficient in the country and, therefore, are now kept out of the purview of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, Consumer Affairs Secretary Leena Nandan said on Tuesday.

On March 13, the Union consumer affairs ministry had declared face masks and hand sanitisers as essential commodities for 100 days to boost supply and prevent hoarding of these items in its fight to check the spread of coronavirus.

Demand for work under MGNREGA has 'sharply' increased amid lockdown

DEMAND FOR WORK under the MGNREGA has more than doubled in this fiscal, so far, due to the Covid-19 lockdown and about 42% of the total allocation of ₹1.01 lakh crore for the employment scheme has already been distributed among states, sources said on Tuesday.

The way demand for work under the Mahatma Gandhi

National Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) has "sharply" increased this year, it seems a sizeable amount will be required to meet demand, they said.

To provide relief to migrant workers who returned to their villages from across the country during the lockdown, the Centre has expanded the ambit work offered under the scheme. It now includes toilet construction and dragon fruit plantation, sources in the gov-

ernment said.

They said only the labour cost for construction of toilets, part of the Swachh Bharat Mission, will be paid under the MGNREGA.

Besides this, dragon fruit plantation, which is mostly done in northeastern states, has also been included in the list of works, the sources said.

Officials in the Rural Development Ministry said the ambit of work has been expanded to provide as many opportuni-

ties as possible to engage migrant workers who have returned to their native states.

Sources in the ministry also suggested that additional funds might be required for the MGNREGA as the demand for work under it has more than doubled compared to last year. Out of the ₹1.01 lakh crore total allocation for the employment guarantee scheme, which also includes the ₹40,000 crore allocated under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana, ₹43,000 crore has already been allocated to states, they said.

SC notice to Centre, DGCA on plea for refund on flight tickets

THE SUPREME COURT Tuesday asked the Centre and the DGCA to respond to a plea seeking directions to airlines to refund full amount of tickets for the flights cancelled due to restrictions imposed in India to contain the pandemic.

A bench headed by Justice Ashok Bhushan issued notices to the Ministry of Civil Aviation and the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) seeking their replies on the plea which has alleged that airlines have failed to refund the ticket amount and are "illegally imposing" the mechanism of 'credit shell' on unwilling passengers.

"Issue notice," said the bench, also comprising Justices S K Kaul and M R Shah.

India won't compromise on data sovereignty, says Prasad

UNION IT AND Telecom Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad on Tuesday said India is an "important digital power" and will not compromise on its data sovereignty.

Speaking at the launch of a ₹1,100-crore data centre built by Hiranandani Group company Yotta, Prasad also said that he aspires India to be a centre for data refining, which will include data cleaning and data research as well while keeping in mind concerns on privacy. The comments from the minister come days after the country blocked 59 Chinese apps on concerns around "sovereignty and security". A day after that, Prasad had termed the move as a "digital strike" and added that the apps were banned to protect data of citizens.

"We shall never compromise on data sovereignty of In-



dia. India being an important digital power, our data sovereignty will be very very important. And we shall ensure that we are never made to do any compromise, nor we will do that (compromise)," Prasad said, speaking at the data centre launch event on Tuesday.

He said cyber security is an important aspect and we should be very cautious about things. Prasad used the metaphor of a highway to stress that infrastructure

building should not stop because of accidents, stressing that being cautious is the key.

Prasad, who handles the electronics, information technology and communications portfolios, said India needs to grow into a data refining centre for the world and also go deeper on the software front by creating products of its own. "With the success of digital india (campaign), India must become a big refinery of data cleaning and processing," the IT minister said, adding that concerns on data privacy should be taken on board while doing so.

At the same time, there are huge projects like the direct benefit transfer, which has helped the government save over ₹1.70 lakh crore in the last few years, or over 3 crore Aadhaar confirmations happening every three minutes wherein data is generated, he said.
