163rd SLBC MEETING—CANARA BANK



163rd SLBC meeting was held on 02-12-2023 at Vidhana Soudha, Bengaluru to review September 2023 quarter progress and was chaired by Rajneesh Goel Chief Secretary, Govt. of Karnataka. Out of total PSA, Agriculture Achievement is 92,907 crores (47.92%) and MSE/MSME is 91,379 crores (47.13%).
